### Please note additional charges:

- Uniform – All Year 9 – Year 13 students are in uniform. Short-term students are allowed to wear their own school uniforms or purchase a uniform if they prefer. All students must be in uniform before they can attend timetabled classes.
- NCEA Examination FEES\* Level 1-3 (Government determined) currently \$383.30 per year are payable extra. The students are invoiced when courses are set and examinations to be taken are confirmed.
- Scholarship subjects\* (\$102.20 per subject) (Government determined) Top academic students may be invited to undertake these examinations and Westlake Girls would cover the fees for these students.
- Requests to supply previous school records – NZD \$50 for first request (\$10 per additional copy).
- Courses (with specific equipment requirements) and sporting activities (including horse riding) incur additional charges.
- Items marked with \* - these services are provided by outside providers and may change. Students will be notified as soon as the latest figures are available.
- For groups – where students share a homestay – the homestay placement can be shared between the two students.
